**Final report for Student Portion Expenditures related to awarding the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Grant
September 30, 2020**

The HEERF, a Federal Department of Education Grant of 2020, given to institutions of higher learning due to the disruption of classes from the Coronavirus (COVID-19), is to assist students who experienced financial hardship during the months of March-May, 2020.

To date, Fred W. Eberle Technical Center has awarded funds from the HEERF to 73 students impacted by the COVID-19 school closure during the Spring semester of 2020. To date, the amount of funds distributed directly to students is \$60,984.99.
